Hi:

Thanks for your telephone call yesterday. I'm glad to hear that you're recovering well from your ordeal of the past several weeks. Here are some notes concerning what has transpired concerning the Loran-C receiver label requirement.

After your call of last month, I drafted a memorandum to G-WWM (copies to G-NRN and G-LRA) concerning the "Label requirement for Loran-C receivers" as we had discussed, stating:

(33 CFR 164.41(c))... "requires the use of a label after 1 July 1982. Because draft RTCM test procedures are not yet approved and available, this requirement cannot be enforced. A rule should be issued waiving the label requirement until two years following the availability of approved RTCM test procedures. Until issuance of that rule, notices should be issued to inform the marine public that the label will not be required for at least two years."

Prior to sending that memorandum, I discussed this matter with Mr. Tom Falvey (GWWM), who said that he was coordinating with Mr. Stan Colby (GLRA) \$\mathbf{I}\$, that that memo was what he wanted and that he was ready to go upon receipt of the memo. This action was to be a follow-on to our CGD 81-081 project.

G-WWM's response was dated 2 APR 1982. I called Mr. Tom Falvey on 22 APR 1982 and asked about "his" memo 16671 dtd 2 APR 1982. I asked him if there were any problem or objection to release of this memo outside of the Coast Guard. He said that there was none. I have therefore attached a copy as you requested. As you can see, G-WWM (Capt. O'Donnell) "does not support the idea ..."

I suggest that you might initially call Mr. Falvey and Capt. O'Donnell (426-4958) to discuss this matter, as they are the people responsible for issuance of any modification of the regulation. Your position as President of Wild Goose Association makes you an ideal emissary on this topic. If you need further assistance from me, or if you want to make representations via RTCM (SC-70), please call me.

This letter expresses my personal opinions, and is not to be taken as representing the opinion or position of anyone else or of the U. S. Coast Guard. Rather, I am responding in the spirit of free interchange of information among RTCM SC-70 members.

- (a) Your Memo 16562 SER 0024P dtd 23 MAR 82
- 1. Reference (a) has been reviewed. Based upon the following factors I do not support the idea of waiving the LORAN C Receiver labeling requirements through the rule making process;
  - a. In my view labeling a receiver only means that the manufacturer has designed and manufactured the unit to meet the specification. Labeling does not mean that the unit has been tested or that it must be tested.
  - b. The label requirements place the onus for meeting the specifications on the manufacturer, and assist in the enforcement process. The label rule only affects LORAN C installations made after 1 June 1982.
  - c. Labeling is not required for Type I or Type II receivers installed before 1 June 1982 until 1 June 1985.
- 2. Overall, the label does not "warrant" that the specifications were met in the same manner as a consumer warranty, but rather as a means to insure all the necessary requirements a receiver should have were considered in its design and manufacture. I hope this information clarifies our position.
